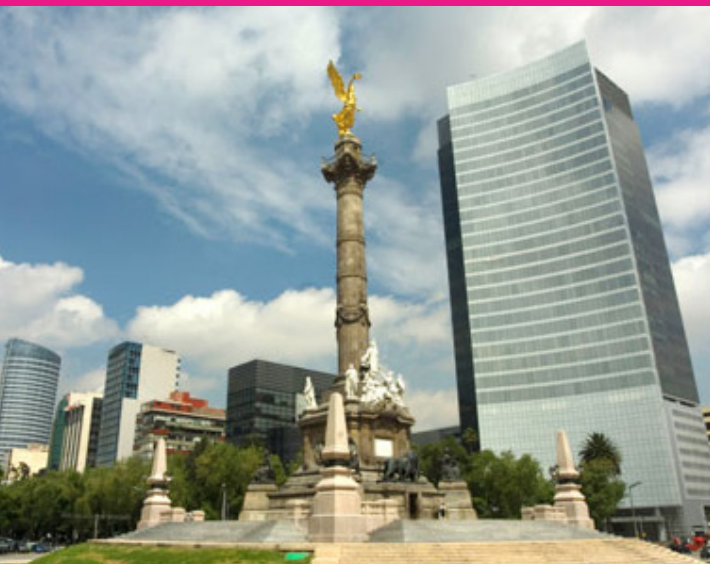

# PROGRAM

**Wednesday, April 24<sup>th</sup>**

Arrivals day.

Private transportation from México City's Benito Juárez International Airport (MEX) to the Four Seasons Hotel México city can be arranged for you on request. Scouts will be at the airport to assist you at every step along the way. And you will be welcomed again by smiling Scouts at the welcome desk in the Four Seasons Hotel.

In the early evening we will have a welcome cocktail and reservations can be made for you in recommended restaurants nearby the hotel or in the hotel's restaurant.

**Thursday, April 25<sup>th</sup>**

We will visit the Mexican Anthropology Museum, the México City Centre, the National Palace, the Metropolitan Cathedral and then the Main Square (Zocalo). In the evening we will attend a cocktail offered by the IPADE Business School followed by a dinner at a traditional Mexican restaurant.

**Friday, April 26<sup>th</sup>**

Today we will visit the Pyramids of Teotihuacan (the city of the gods), which is one of the biggest Mesoamerican cities. Hector Robledo – WSF Board Member, will host the lunch - at his private home in a typical Mexican tradition. The Fellowship Dinner will take place at a historical and very exclusive venue in downtown México City.



**Saturday, April 27<sup>th</sup>**



Several Scout groups have put together an event, which will give you an insight into Mexican Scouting. This will be your chance to experience a dazzling exhibition of skills and activities, and hear from the scouts themselves of "their" life in Scouting. The lunch will be together with your new Scout friends.
